A Message from Fr. Mark

Dear Parishioners,

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, and we will hear that famous reading that tells us how to do our Lenten practices of praying, fasting, and almsgiving. They are the words of Jesus from the Sermon on the Mount in the Gospel of Matthew (6:1-18). Whoever wants to "enter the Kingdom of Heaven" must do these things out of love for God and neighbor. Each of us should decide what we will try to do differently during the forty days of Lent.

First, Jesus says that we should show our love for our neighbor by giving alms. We should give to the poor and we should also give to the Lord's church, which is the Body of Christ continuing his saving mission in the world. This weekend we are asking that everyone give a planned gift to the Bishop's Ministry

Appeal so that our local church can continue to function.

Second, Jesus says that we should pray. Perhaps you can make a resolution to pray the rosary every day during the forty days of Lent, to pray as a family, to go to confession and Communion more often. Beginning in Lent we will be offering Masses and Confession times on weekday evenings here at Presentation Church.

Third, you might decide that during Lent you want to make a commitment to pray fast or to do some act of bodily penance. This means giving up sweets or meats. Or you can fast from alcohol or the internet or from your favorite TV shows during lent. These little sacrifices help us raise our minds to God and we can "offer it up" for the salvation of our loved ones.



Ironically, our Lenten Mission will not be about fasting! We will hear spiritual talks from a famous chef, Father Leo Patalinghug. On the following day, there will be a gourmet dinner at which Fr. Leo will give a cooking demonstration. Bring your appetite!

May God bless us and help us to be holy during these forty days of Lent. In today's Gospel Jesus tells us to love our enemies and turn the other cheek so that we can "Be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect" (Matthew 5:38-48).

Ash Wednesday

What is that on your head? Who hasn't gotten that question on Ash Wednesday before? Do you feel silly when people ask you about your ashes? And is it hard to answer their questions? Having ashes on your forehead isn't just some weird Catholic thing; it's a tradition that finds its roots in the Old Testament. "I turned to the Lord God, to seek help, in prayer and petition, with fasting, sackcloth, and ashes" (Daniel 9:3). When the ashes are placed on our foreheads in the sign of the Cross, it is a reminder of several things. First, it is a call to repentance: a physical sign that we are sinners in need of forgiveness, which is how the prophets used it in the Old Testament. Second, it is to remind us that God created us from the earth and when we die, we will return to it. But here's the best part: As Pope Benedict XVI has said, "Man is dust and to dust he shall return, but dust is precious in God's eyes because God created man, destining him to immortality." God so loves us that, even when our

bodies return to the dust, our souls are meant to live forever with him. The ashes symbolize all of this. Not so silly anymore, is it?

All you do is give up candy? Now, here is an interesting question. External sacrifices are the most obvious kind, so sometimes it does look like all we do is avoid chocolate. However, if you look closer, you'll realize that fasting and abstinence have always gone hand in hand with two of their best friends: prayer and almsgiving. External sacrifice is a manifestation of interior conversion: "...interior conversion urges expression in visible signs, gestures and works of penance" (CCC no. 1430). Interior conversion is where prayer and almsgiving come into play. In almsgiving, we show mercy and generosity to others, giving them a chance to experience the blessings we have. In prayer, we are communicating with God, asking him to bless and perfect our fasting and almsgiving: "... prayer is the living relationship of the children of God with their Father who is good beyond measure, with his Son Jesus Christ and with the Holy Spirit" (CCC no. 2565). It's not just avoiding sweets. It's glorifying God by growing in his Love.

Ministry Spotlight Continued

FASTING & ABSTINENCE DURING LENT

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. Fasting is obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

Abstinence laws consider that meat comes only from animals such as chickens, cows, sheep or pigs, all of which live on land. Birds are also considered meat. Abstinence does not include meat juices and liquid foods made from meat. Fish are a different category of animal. Salt and freshwater species of fish and shellfish are permitted.

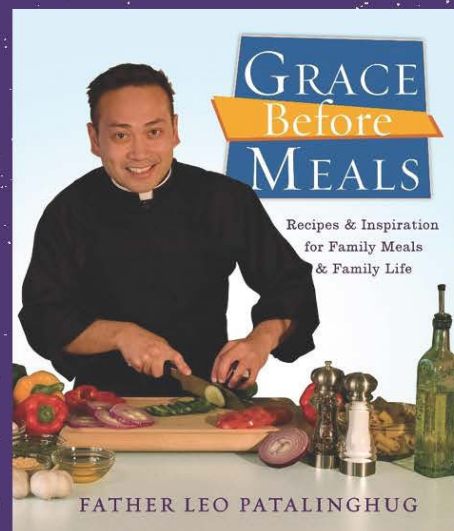
