A Message from Fr. Mark

Dear Parishioners,

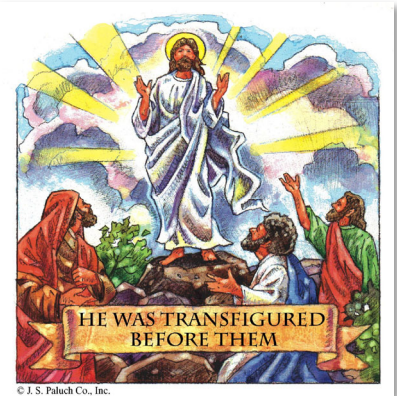
In 2014 a movie came out about the life of Jesus called "Son of God." It was not the best of movies about Jesus, but nevertheless, I liked it because it clearly showed that Jesus is the Son of God with the power to do miracles like healing the paralytic, multiplying fish and walking on water (some movies skip over the miraculous). Yet at the same time, it depicts Jesus as a fairly ordinary man who seems to really need the friendship of Peter and the other disciples. The actor who played Jesus did a pretty good job of playing the role of the one who is both true God and true man. It is probably impossible for an actor to portray a human and happy Jesus who is at the same

time the Divine Word of God who continually sustains all creation in existence.

In today's Gospel, we see Jesus choosing his best friends Peter, James, and John to keep Him company on Mount Tabor.

They saw the Face of the Divine Jesus transfigured and shining like the sun. The same three friends would later see the same Face covered with sweaty blood in the garden of Gethsemane where Jesus suffered a very human agony before ascending Mount Calvary.

Lent is a journey of conversion so that more and more we can be Jesus' friends whom He needs for the work of salvation.



Although we have human weakness, we can share in the Divine: like Jesus and with Jesus!

We contemplate the Holy Face of our Friend. We ask that we may too share in the Divinity of Jesus who humbled himself to share in our humanity!

Saint of the Week

St. Frances of Rome (1384-1440)

Feast Day: March 9

This laywoman and foundress, born a Roman aristocrat, married Lorenzo Ponziano when she was 13; they had several children. From an early age, Frances lived a life devoted to God in prayer and service to the poorest of the poor. In 1409, their palazzo was pillaged by Neapolitan soldiers and Lorenzo was exiled for five years, returning home a broken man. He died in 1436. When the great plague hit Rome, Frances sold all of her belongings to buy items for the sick. Frances, known for her great charity during epidemics and civil war,

organized a ladies society dedicated to self-denial and good works as ministers to the poor in Rome. It became the Oblates of Tor de Specchi, which she directed for her last four years. She is the patron saint of motorists, perhaps because she was guarded for 23 years by an archangel visible only to her. Her last words were: "The angel has finished his work. He is beckoning me to follow."

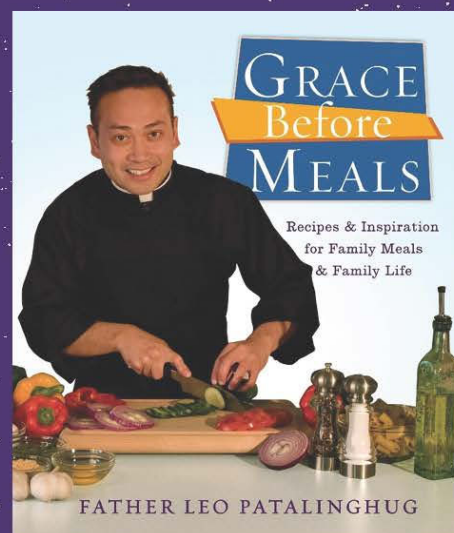
