Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

January 26, 2020

A Message from Fr. Mark

"Upon those who dwelt in the land of gloom a light has shone." These are the words of our first reading from the Old Testament (Isaiah 9:1), which were also quoted by St. Matthew in our Gospel Reading (Matthew 4:16). The arrival of Jesus in Galilee was the occasion for proclaiming this joyful good news. However, these words can also be applied whenever the light of Christ shines in our dark world.

Yesterday a light shone in San Francisco as we walked for life and radiated the joy of our Catholic belief that all human life is sacred! Unfortunately, there are always a few who oppose us, but often it is because they are misinformed about the realities of abortion. Some people think that abortion is a positive thing for women. I learned otherwise when I heard the testimony of a woman psychologist who came to speak to all of the priests of the Stockton Diocese several years ago. Her name is Dr. Theresa Burke, and she told the story of something that happened early in her career as a psychologist. She was leading a support group for women who suffered from eating disorders. As each of them shared their stories, it was revealed that several of them had had abortions. As Dr. Burke got to know each of these women, she later discovered that ALL of them had had abortions! This caused her to change her entire practice and to refocus her career on helping women overcome the devastating effects of Post-Abortion Syndrome. She wrote a marvelous book called "Forbidden Grief: The Unspoken Pain of Abortion", which reveals the truth of how women are always torn up inside after an abortion, both physically and emotionally, regardless of whether they understand the cause of their inner grief. For many of these women, their

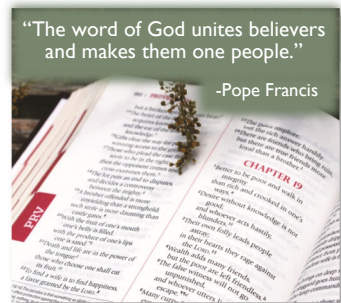

Saint of the Week

St. Thomas Aquinas

Feast Day: January 28

Thomas so shocked his noble Italian family when he entered the Dominicans about 1244 that his brothers imprisoned him for a year. But he would not yield, and studied under St. Albert the Great, becoming a master of theology in 1256. For the rest of his brief life, the "dumb ox," as he was dubbed, taught, preached and wrote, producing the monumental "Summa Theologica." His thinking became enormously influential in later centuries and he was named a Doctor of the Church in 1567.

"St Thomas Aquinas, with farsighted wisdom,

succeeded in establishing a fruitful confrontation with the Arab and Hebrew thought of his time, to the point that he was considered an ever up-to-date teacher of dialogue with other cultures and religions. He knew how to present that wonderful Christian synthesis of reason and faith which today too, for the Western civilization, is a precious patrimony to draw from for an effective dialogue with the great cultural and religious traditions of the East and South of the world." -Pope Benedict XVI, Angelus

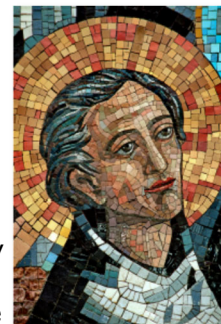

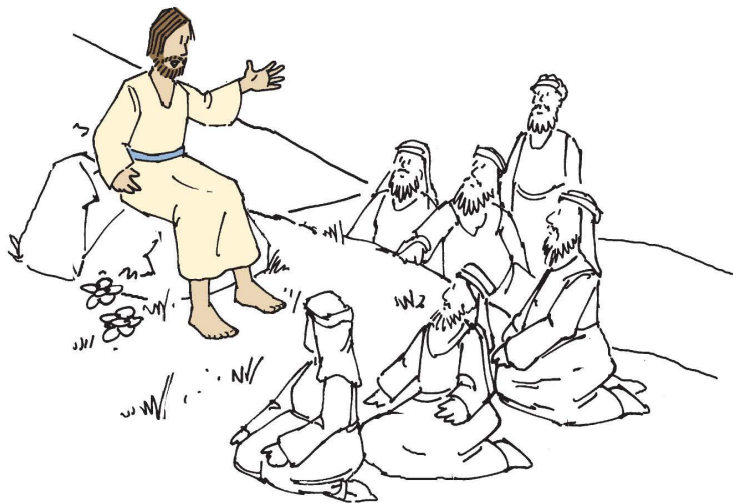
